To provide knowledge in assurance of fire security.</p> <p>Tasks of the course: to foster students' individual use of theoretical knowledge and skills for solution of practical problems.</p>

To make convincing conclusions on the chosen theme by purposefully using the corresponding literature and normative documents. The research paper is to be elaborated according to methodological instructions and regulations of record keeping.

Successfully fulfilled home task (research paper in amount of 10-12 pages) on the theme, given by academic staff, with the assessment no less than "4" - "almost satisfactory" forms differentiated test on the study course.
